

## Facilities Available

### **Accessible Toilets**

We will have a number of accessible toilets on site at Cambridge Pride. The locations of these are included on the site map.

### **Viewing Platforms**

We will have an accessible viewing platform at the main stage. This is run on a first come, first served basis.

### **Access Reception/Team**

The Access Team will be based on site if you have any questions or queries on the day of Cambridge Pride. The location of the Access Reception will be confirmed at a later date, as will what the Access Team will be wearing.

### **Parade Accessibility**

We welcome everyone to take part in the parade. Please contact [yvette@cambridgepride.co.uk](mailto:yvette@cambridgepride.co.uk) to discuss and plan any specific access needs.

### **Quiet Space**

We are hoping to provide a Quiet Space again this year. More details about this will be provided closer to the event.

### **BSL**

We will have BSL interpreters for all performances that have words or lyrics. The interpreters will generally be located to the left of the main stage. BSL assisted performance times will be confirmed closer to the event.

### **Assistance Dogs**

Registered assistance dogs are welcome on site. We ask you to please consider the welfare of these animals when in loud and crowded areas.

### **Bars and Traders Adjustments**

We aim to have large print plain text menus available at all bars and traders this year.

## **Medical Fridge**

We will have a Medical Fridge on site for storing medication.

### **On Street Parking for Blue Badge Holders**

Blue Badge holders can park on double yellow lines for up to 3 hours, where no other restrictions are in place (such as loading area, or loading restrictions, zebra crossing etc.)

**“When you park on yellow lines or in other places where there is a time restriction, you need to display the blue parking clock to show your time of arrival. The clock should be sent to you together with the Blue Badge. If not, you can get a clock from the same council that issued the badge.” – Gov.uk**

If you need to use a parking clock, you must display it on the vehicle's dashboard or fascia panel, so that the time can be seen clearly through the front windscreen. The clock should be set to show the quarter hour period during which you arrived. If there is no dashboard or fascia panel in your vehicle, you must still display the clock in a place where it can be clearly read from outside the vehicle.
